- 2. Sponsorship at any amount or level is appreciated and will be recognized in written materials distributed on the day of the walk . Our Walk will likely have approximately 200 walkers and 50 volunteer workers.
- Sponsorship at the \$100 level or above will be recognized by a professionally prepared sign placed on the course during the walk as well by recognition in the written materials.
- 4. Sponsorship at the \$250 level or above will be recognized by the sign and written materials. In addition we will be glad to distribute any promotional material for your business you wish to provide to us. This year we will distribute 500 cloth grocery bags on the day of the walk and thereafter through the St. Vincent Food Pantry. Your materials will be included
