Friends of the Poor Walk Sponsor Information

THANK YOU for considering Sponsorship of St. Vincent de Paul's "Friends of the Poor" Walk during a time when the economy makes it very difficult to do so. Here is some information you may want to know:

1. The Evansville District Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul is affiliated with the Catholic church and operates as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. This "Walk" is one of approximately 160 walks being held in cities throughout the United States.
2. Sponsorship at any amount or level is appreciated and will be recognized in written materials distributed on the day of the walk . Our Walk will likely have approximately 250 walkers and 50 volunteer workers.
3. Sponsorship at the \$100 level or above will be recognized by a professionally prepared sign placed on the course during the walk as well by recognition in the written materials.
4. Sponsorship at the \$250 level or above will be recognized by the sign and written materials. In addition we will be glad to distribute any promotional material for your business you wish to provide to us. This year we will distribute 500 cloth grocery bags on the day of the walk and thereafter through the St. Vincent Food Pantry. Your materials will be included
5. Sponsorship at the \$500 level or above will be recognized as above and in addition we will have space available for you to promote your business or activity during the day of the walk near the start or finish area.
6. Sponsorship of \$1,000 or more will be recognized by having your name or logo printed on the shopping bags we give to each walker and distribute through the Food Pantry throughout the year after the walk.
7. If a business wishes to be a "Title Sponsor" for a donation of \$2500 or more, that sponsorship will be recognized by a banner at the start/finish line, and by having that sponsorship printed on the shopping bags.
