Making A Difference -

- *The Evansville District Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul helps individuals and families in Vanderburgh, Warrick, Posey and Gibson Counties*
- *In the past fiscal year, our district council's 450 volunteer members, called "Vincentians," responded to over 5000 requests for assistance impacting over 12,000 individuals*
- *Over \$400,000 was provided to help those in financial need pay for life's basic necessities*
- *The Evansville District Council's Vincentians donated over \$58,000 of their own funds to assist those in need.*
- *Our Vincentians volunteered nearly 17,000 hours between St. Vincent de Paul's Food Pantry and Thrift Store*
- *Our Food Pantry distributed over 73,000 boxes and bags of three-day supplies of essentials, totaling over 250 tons of food*
- *Through a grant from the Vanderburgh County "Community Good Grants Program," our Thrift Store was able to provide 42 twin beds to families through a partnership with Ireland Home Based Services*
- *Our 19 parish-based conferences, through the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store, provided clothing, furniture, and household items to over 3000 individuals*
- *Our Vincentians not only provide financial assistance to those in need, but even more importantly, spiritual assistance through their prayers, presence and listening*
