

SNAP Supplement for Children Under Six



What is it?

A supplemental benefit that will be issued by FSSA/DFR to eligible children under six who are receiving or previously received SNAP. Families already receiving SNAP benefits will have the additional benefits applied to their Hoosier Works cards. Families not currently receiving SNAP, but who were eligible during the specified time period, will receive a EBT card in the mail.

Who is Eligible?

Children who:

- Are under 6 in a SNAP household any time during October 2020 through September 2021 **AND**
- Are eligible to receive childcare and the childcare facility is closed or operating with reduced attendance or hours, **OR**
- If they live in the area of a school that is closed or operating with a virtual or hybrid schedule

Do We Have to Apply?

No. DFR will identify all children under 6 who are or have been enrolled in a SNAP household during the eligibility period. Please refer to [https://www.in.gov/fssa/dfr/](https://www.in.gov/fssa/df/) for more information.

What Amount Will We Receive and When?

Supplemental benefits will be issued based on a retrospective quarterly basis. For example, benefits due for October-December 2020 will be issued in a single issuance in March 2021. This supplemental benefit will be equal to the average statewide P-EBT benefit issued to school children during that quarter. The monthly statewide average is \$67.97. The first quarter (October-December 2020) amount will be \$203.91 if the child is eligible for all three months.
