S.A.F.E. (Seniors Against Fearful Environments)
S.A.F.E. provides transportation for preregistered Seniors and wheelchair bound
residents to safely cash checks, pay bills, fill
medical prescriptions, and grocery shop. In
the wake of COVID-19 we currently offer
transportation to vaccinations, testing, food
banks, and other essential services.

#### Suited and Booted

The Suited and Booted program provides interview attire for men and women job seekers. The participants are given one suit upon applying for assistance. However, after full-time employment is obtained participants receive an additional week of business professional or business casual work attire.

### F.L.O.W. (Future Leaders of the World)

The F.L.O.W. mentor program prepares children ages 5-18 years for the next level. F.L.O.W. incorporates college preparatory and character-building skills such as Self-Empowerment, Critical Thinking, Cultural & Diversity training, Volunteerism, Conflict Resolution, Anger Management, Goal Setting, Budgeting, and Crime Intervention.

### **Missing Pieces Employment Express**

The M.P.E.E. program provides transportation to higher paying worksites not accessible via normal METS and city bus routes. Preregistered participants can be transported to worksites along HWY 41 (Monday-Friday) as far North as Toyota Motors Manufacturing in Princeton, Indiana and as far East as Shoe Carnival Warehouse along HWY 57.
