## Your Dollars Make A Difference -

- Last fiscal year, the Evansville District of St. Vincent de Paul partnered with YWCA, Ozanam Family Shelter, and other agencies to provide clothing at minimal cost to those they serve.
- Provided \$650,000 in direct assistance to over 12,000 individuals to cover rent, utilities, and other essentials.
- Distributed 427,000 pounds of food from our Pantry to individuals and families.
- Had over 36,500 hours of service volunteered at our Food Pantry, Thrift Store, and in the Parish Conferences with nearly 50,000 miles driven to visit those in need.
- Commenced its first group of "Getting Ahead," a systemic change initiative for those living in poverty.
- Partnered with Prevent Child Abuse Vanderburgh County and Sleep in Heavenly Peace to provide twin beds for children in need.
- Brought prayer, kindness, and hope to their neighbors in need.
