## Your Dollars Make A Difference -

- Last fiscal year, the Evansville District of St. Vincent de Paul partnered with YWCA, Ozanam Family Shelter, Salvation Army, United Caring Services, and Aurora to provide clothing at minimal or no cost to those they serve.
- Provided over \$770,000 in direct assistance to more than 14,000 individuals to cover rent, utilities, and other essentials.
- Distributed over 340 tons of food from our Pantry to almost 31,000 individuals.
- Had over 43,000 hours of service volunteered at our Food Pantry, Thrift Store, and in the Parish Conferences with over 61,000 miles driven to visit those in need.
- Completed another group of "Getting Ahead," a systemic change initiative for those living in poverty.
- Offered a financial counseling and credit building program to help those in poverty avoid the trap of predatory lenders.
- Brought prayer, kindness, and hope to their neighbors in need.
